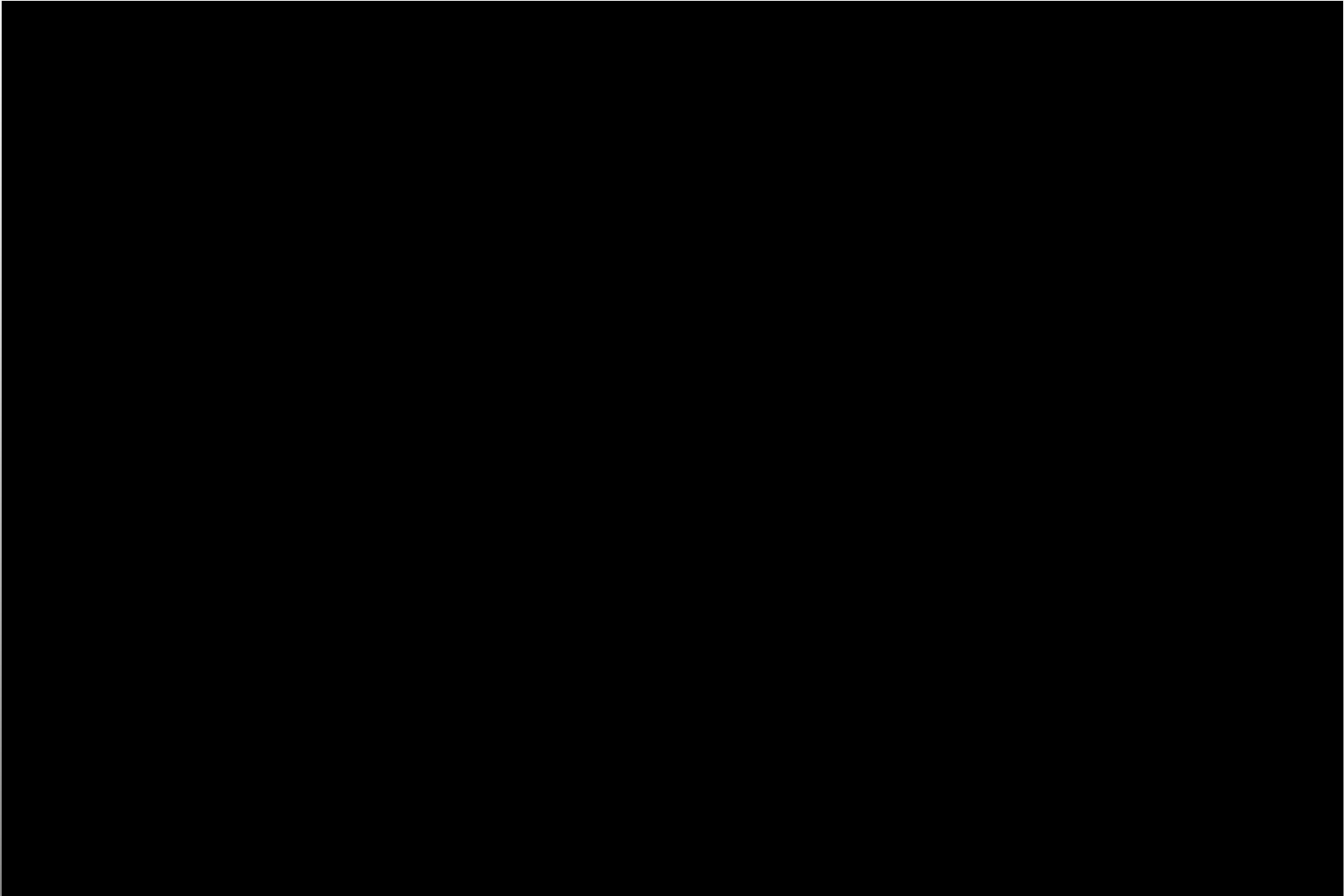

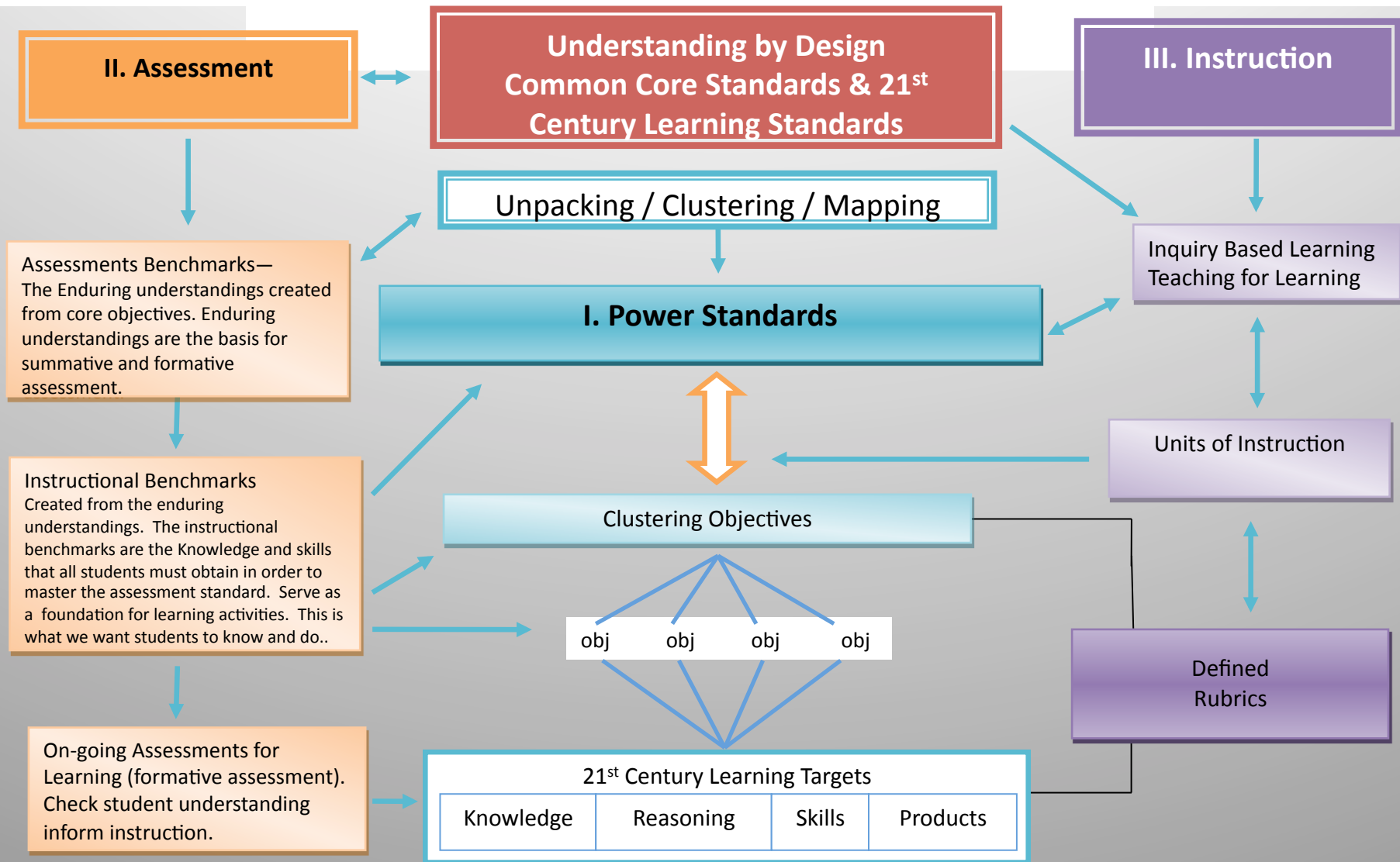

Common Core & 21st Century Instruction

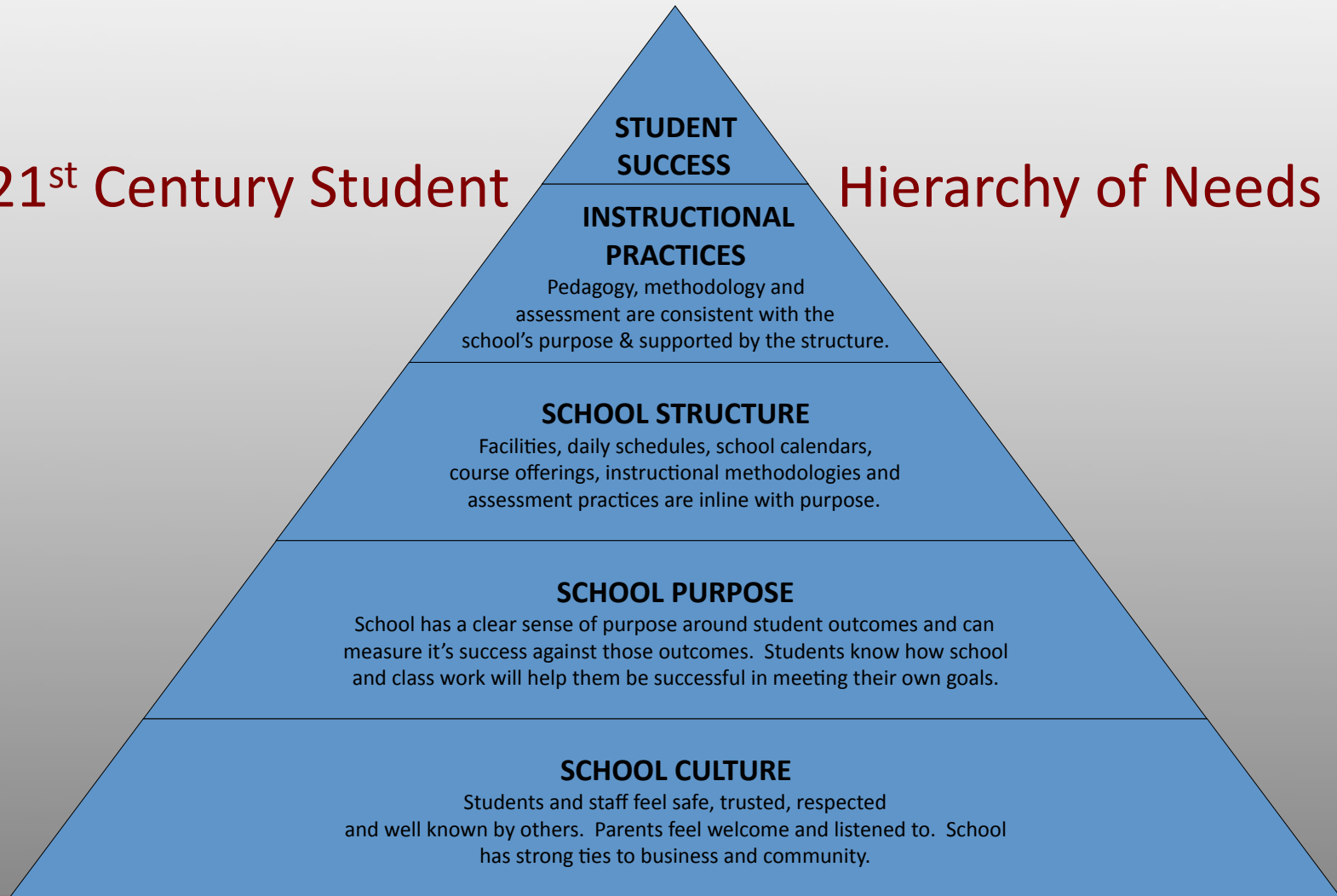
