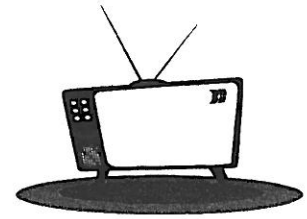


# The Village of Oak Lawn

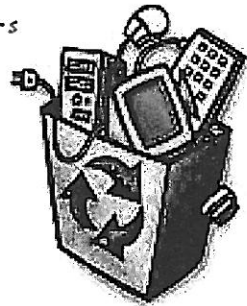

The collection site is located at the Village of Oak Lawn Public Works Garage located at 5532 W. 98<sup>th</sup> Street.

## Drop-Off Instructions

- Bring only residentially generated electronic items. No Business electronics will be taken. Businesses are encouraged to participate in the Semi-Annual Recycling Event hosted by the Village. See website for dates and details.
- **CLEAN OFF ANY PERSONAL INFORMATION ON HARD DRIVES (Village is not responsible for any information stored on computer equipment left for recycling)**
- Take materials to the drop-off **ONLY** during hours of operation.
- Please place materials carefully in boxes indicated by signs at the site.
- **DO NOT TAKE** any items that have already been dropped off. Once items have been placed in the collection box, they are part of the Recycling Program.
- **This area is monitored via video surveillance twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week.**
