• Strategic Plan Draft – Dr. Enderle and the Board reviewed the draft strategic plan with Bob Ewy. Mr. Ewy used environmental scans, the community survey, and information from previous meetings to create the draft plan. The Board reviewed the four goals and stated

11.26.2018 Snow Day - Calendar Amendment

Dr. Enderle discussed the options with the Board for making up the snow day on November 26, 2018. The district currently has a waiver which would allow Casmir Pulaski Day to be used in place of an Emergency Day at the end of the school year. This would cost the district approximately \$8,000 due to paying staff who would normally have that day off. Using an emergency day at the end of the year would not cost the district extra. After some discussion, the consensus was to use a scheduled emergency

day.
