
D123 Fine Arts Festival

<u>WHAT</u>: An event highlighting the fine arts talents of all D123 students. Students are encouraged to submit a project in one (maximum of 2) of the subcategories below. <u>More specific details relative to project submissions can be found on the reverse side</u>.

- ❖ *Visual Arts:* Accepted visual arts include: architectural drawings and models, ceramics, collage, computer generated images and graphics, crafts, drawing, fashion clothes and jewelry, fiber work, mixed media, painting, printmaking and sculpture.
- **Photography:** Photo must be a single print/digital image. Entrant must be the photographer and may use a variety of digital editing techniques including but not limited to, multiple exposure, negative sandwich and photogram. Image dimensions must be no smaller than 3x5 inches and no larger than 8x10 inches.
- * *Film:* Accepted short film styles include: Animation, narrative, documentary, dance choreography or singing performance (solo & ensemble accepted) media presentation. Entrant must be the screenwriter, cinematographer, editor and producer. No Tik Toks, please.
- ❖ *Literature:* Accepted forms of fiction and nonfiction include: prose, poetry, reflective essay, screen-play and play script, narrative, and short story. Entrants may write in their primary language as long as an interpretive English translation is also attached. Use of copyrighted material is prohibited. Writing must not exceed 2,000 words and may be handwritten or typed.

The theme is "MY WORLD"

<u>WHO</u>: *All students*, preschool through 8th grade, general education and special education students alike. The participation eligibility is divided into *four divisions*:

- ❖ Primary (preschool 2nd grade)
- ♦ Intermediate (3rd 5th grade)
- **♦** Middle School (6th 8th grade)
- *Special Artist (all grades)

WHEN & WHERE: Projects will be due to your feeder school on Friday, February 28, 2020. The Fine Arts Festival itself will be held on Wednesday, March 18, 2020, 6:00 - 7:30 PM at Oak Lawn-Hometown Middle School.

Project Guidelines:

- Entrees must be an original work of only ONE student.
- Please try to limit project size to 28 X 22 inches or smaller.
- All entries will be returned the evening of the Fine Arts Festival. Winning entries will be returned to their home schools for display!
- Students may submit no more than two entries (must be in two different categories)
- Submission form attached MUST BE submitted with all entries.
- Student artwork will be categorized and judged by grade level, preschool through 8th grade.
- All categories will be independently judged by a third party on artistic merit, creativity, and interpretation of theme.
- ❖ Each category will include a 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place.
