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KIDS Assessment (All kindergarten teachers must be trained)	The Kindergarten Individual Development Survey (KIDS) is an observational tool designed to improve understanding of children's development in key areas of learning for long-term success, including social and emotional learning, language and literacy, mathematics, and approaches to learning. This is not a "test" but is a set of documented teacher observations of students' demonstration of developmental skills and interactions.
