How Do I Make Smart Choices This Year?

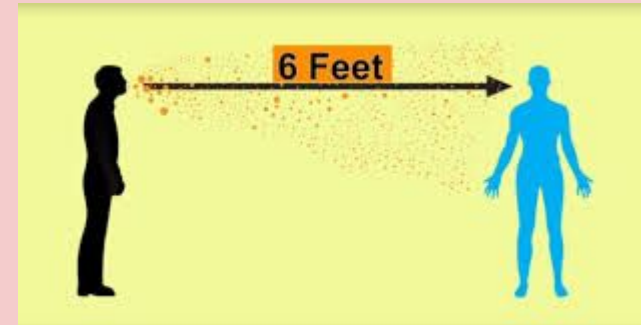
- You are always making choices

- Keep outside doors closed

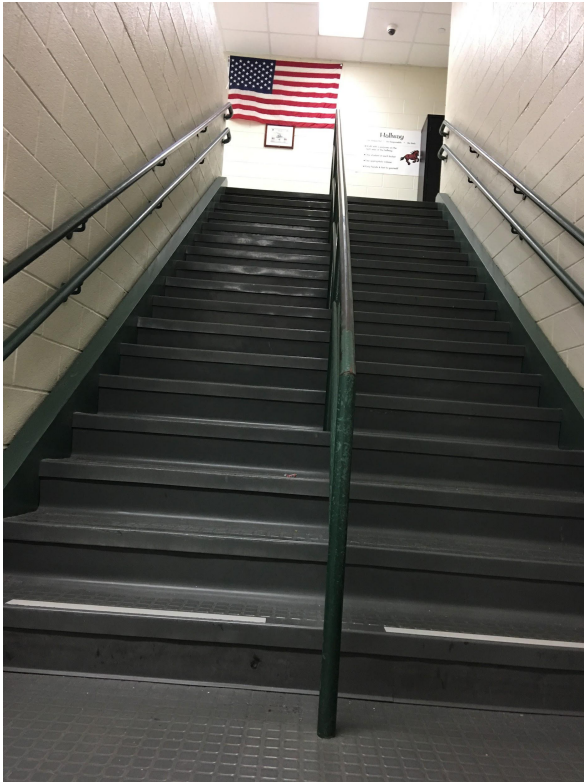
Be Responsible

- Honor others' privacy

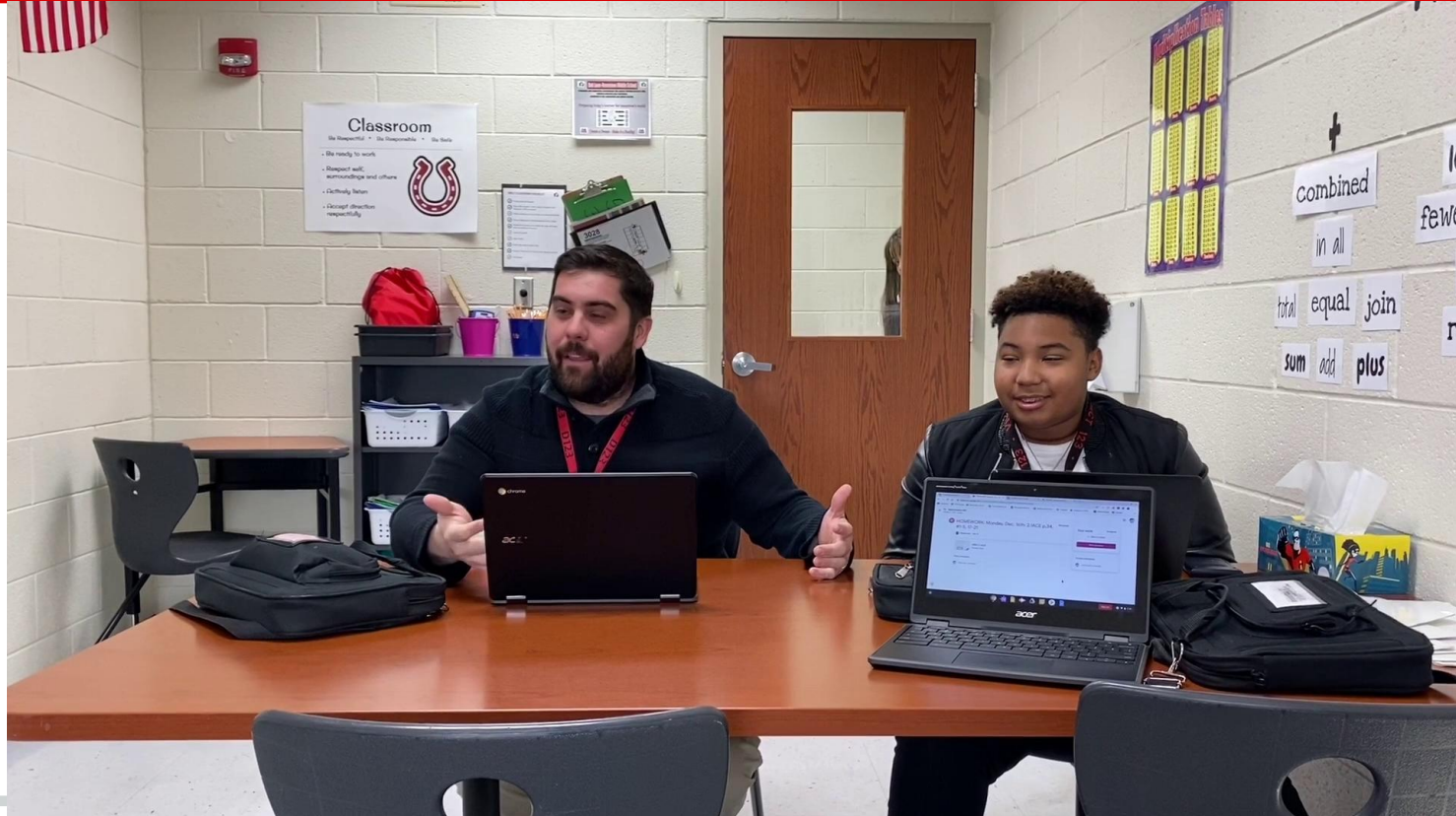
Be Responsible

- Maintain distancing

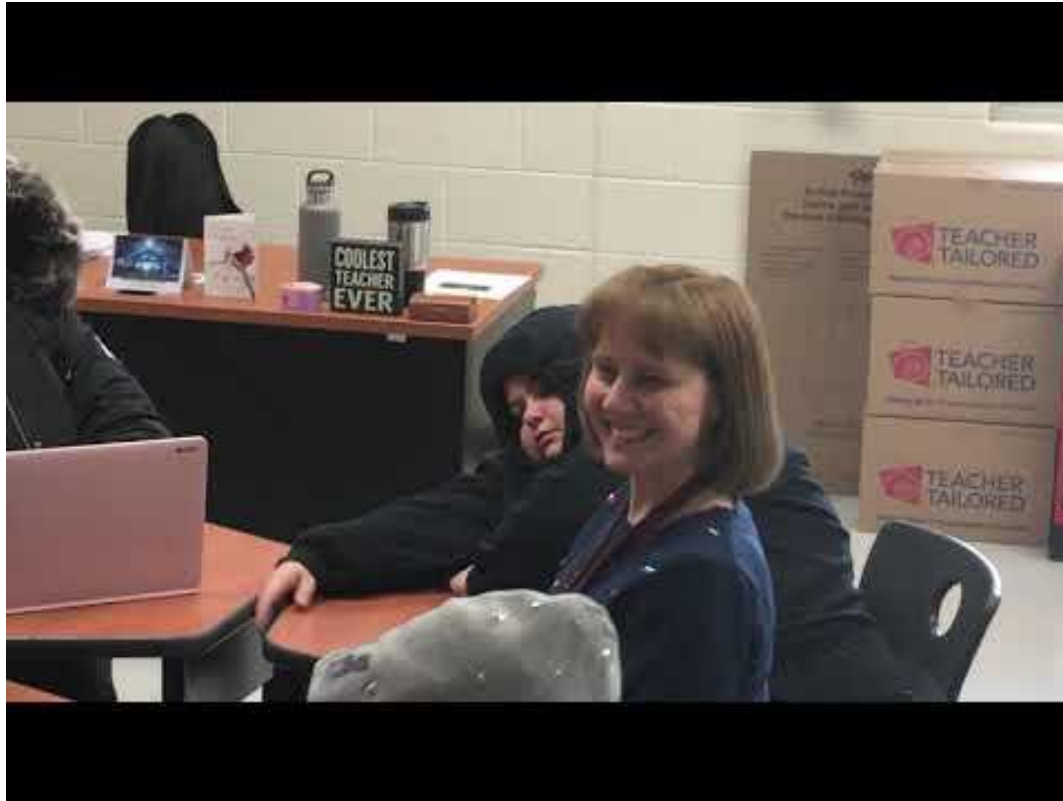
Be Responsible

ID/Dress Code

Be Respectful
